The Tradition Continues.....

All of us associated with the Portland Roadster Show are proud to be a part of one of the biggest and longest running shows in the country. We also have the distinction of being the only all volunteer show of it's kind and size. Our rich 63 year heritage was founded by a fellowship of car enthusiasts here in the Portland metropolitan area that became the Multnomah Hot Rod Council. The Tradition Continues as we promote cars, clubs, and community spirit while supporting a number of charities in the area through our efforts. We appreciate your desire to share your car with us and our guests, and we look forward to meeting you and your family, as we produce a truly great show at the Portland Expo Center. The "Cars are the Stars" at our show, but we also focus on having something for everyone, and entertaining the "Hot Rod Family."

March 15th-17th, 2019

All High School Challenge vehicles will move-in and set-up on Wednesday March 13th, 2019, beginning at 10:00am and must be completed by 8:00pm. If your vehicle is not in the hall by 8:00pm, your vehicle will not be in this years show.

All entries must be set-up and ready for judging by 4:00pm on Thursday March 14th, 2019

Displays may not be taken down, or vehicle moved, until after the show is announced closed on Sunday March 17th. All vehicles must be removed from the facility by 10:00 Sunday evening, or your vehicle will be towed at your expense. Any special arrangements regarding move-in, or move-out, must be made prior to entry deadline.

Entry Procedure:

1. All vehicle fuel tanks will be inspected, and **any vehicle with over 1/4 tank of fuel will be denied entry.**
2. Check in will be at the desk at entry to the hall. Please have your acceptance letter with you. You will then be given your show placard and safety inspection checklist.
3. Someone will guide you to your display location.

Exhibit Space Information: The High School Challenge location and spaces will be designated at the Show Producers discretion. Special space size requests must be pre-arranged and approved by the Show Producers. Your display must fit with the designated area. Stanchions and chains are provided free of charge by the PRS, but you may supply your own if part of your display. They must not restrict the view of yours, or other vehicles.

Vehicle Inspection: Once you are set-up, locate a Safety Inspector for completion of the Safety Inspection Checklist.

1. Batteries must be disconnected, and cable ends taped.
2. Fuel level will be verified, and fuel caps must be taped.
3. Vehicle batteries, in or out of the vehicle, may not be used as a power supply for your display.
4. Any vehicle move after being inspected, must be re-inspected. Failure to comply with the Safety Requirements or the Safety Inspection, will render your vehicle ineligible, and will be removed from the show.
5. If towing is required, it will be at the owner's expense, and there will be no refund of any entry or other fees paid.

Please Note: ALL entries, operable or not, including bare shells or rolling chassis, must be inspected and certified as safe. Vehicles not complying will be removed from the show by the order of the Portland Fire Bureau in accordance with the Uniform Fire Code.

Your Exhibitor Package: After set-up and inspection, return your completed Safety Inspection Checklist and placard to the check-in desk to receive your exhibitor package. Each entry will receive on exhibitor package which will include two (2) Exhibitor Passes, one (1) dash plaque, and any promotional materials provided by our sponsors. If you purchased parking passes or any additional items, they will be included in your package. Please review the contents to ensure that you have all the items listed and/or requested. Extra show passes may be purchased for \$10.00 at the souvenir booth, until the show opens on Friday. 3 Day parking passes are also available for \$30.00.

Vehicle Inspection: Once set-up, contact a Safety Inspector for verification and certification of the **Safety Inspection Checklist**. Batteries must be disconnected and cable ends taped, gas caps must be taped, and fuel level will be verified. **Vehicle batteries in or out of the vehicle, may NOT be used as a power supply. Any vehicle moved after being inspected, MUST be re-inspected. Failure to comply with the Safety Requirements or the Safety Inspection will render your vehicle ineligible, and it will be removed. If towing is required, it will be at owners expense, and there will be no refund of your entry fees.**

Please Note: ALL entries operable or not, including bare shells & chassis must be inspected and certified safe. **Vehicles NOT complying will be removed from the show by the order of the Portland Fire Bureau in accordance with their Uniform Fire Code.**

Your Exhibitor Package: After set-up and inspection, return your **completed Safety Inspection Checklist** card to the **Check-In Desk** to receive your exhibitor package. One exhibitor package will given to each show entry. Each exhibitor package will include two (2) Full Exhibitor Passes, as well as any promotional items provided by our sponsors. If you ordered parking passes or any additional materials, they will also be included in your package. **Immediately review the contents to ensure that you have all items that you requested.** Extra show passes will be available for \$10.00 at the show office until the show opens on Friday. Extra 3-Day Parking Passes are also available for \$30.00 each.

Electrical Information: If your display requires electricity, this must be coordinated and contracted separately with the Expo's electrical contractor. Contact Hollywood Lighting at 503-232-9001 or thru their website at www.hollywoodlights.biz. **All lamps must be shielded from direct contact by small children, and must not create glare into the eyes of our show attendees. Battery operated displays/lights are NOT permitted per Uniform Fire Code.** LED lights and other "cold" forms of illumination are under review, and until approved by the Fire Marshall will **not** be allowed. **Vehicle batteries whether in or out of vehicle, may not be used as a power supply. Power Inverters (110vAC-12vDC) are acceptable as a power supply with Hollywood Lights approval.**

Portland Roadster Show High School Challenge Vehicle Selection Criteria:

1. Vehicles will be invited to, or may apply for acceptance to the Portland Roadster Show. The Show Producers will have the final say on all vehicles accepted to the show
2. Vehicles may be shown more than once during the exhibitors years in high school, but if they win one of the top awards i.e. Les Schwab or the Roll Away Tool Boxes, they are ineligible to win that award a second time.
3. Vehicles that have been significantly changed from the time of application, may be turned away during move-in, and not allowed to show.

This form must be signed and is an integral part of the entry application.

The exhibitor hereby applies to the producer of the Portland Roadster Show (PRS) referred to above to have the vehicle described above displayed therein and agrees that, if the application is accepted, he will display the vehicle at the show under the following terms and conditions:

- A) The aforesaid show shall be duly sanctioned by the International Show Car Association (ISCA) and shall be a part of the ISCA Championship Series Competition.
- B) The show shall be produced in accordance with the Portland Roadster Show, ISCA Classifications, and rule book and/or further rules, regulations and policies adopted or promulgated by the PRS/MHRC or the producer as of the date of the show. The exhibitor or the producer shall be bound by all said rules, regulations, and policies.
- C) Most shows are necessarily overbooked by 10%. In such cases where space is not available for an entry already accepted to the show, the producer will have sole authority to deny entrance to the building to vehicles arriving after the building capacity has been reached. Exhibitors denied access to the building, will be refunded any monies, upon request.
- D) As between the exhibitor and the producer, the producer shall have the final authority to determine the location of an exhibitor's display within the show, and the exhibitor's compliance with the aforesaid rules, regulations and policies.
- E) **Once the exhibitor's display and/or vehicle are set up in the show, they shall not be moved, removed or concealed by the exhibitor prior to the end of the show without the permission of the manager/producer. Any violators of this rule will be removed from the judging competition.**
- F) Neither the producer, a sponsor, nor any officer, director or shareholder, thereof or the owner of the building at which the show is produced, shall be responsible or liable for any loss or damage to all or any part of the exhibitor's personal property, which shall specifically include, but is not limited to, the exhibitor's vehicle, trailer, display material and/or parts, and the exhibitor hereby waives any and all rights it may have against them or any of them for such loss or damage. Exhibitor agrees to obtain insurance covering the above and assumes full responsibility of any loss or damage. Exhibitor agrees that this signed entry form supersedes any and all prior agreements and understandings whether written or oral between the exhibitor and producer, its producer's, show staff, representatives and sub-contractors. Nothing herein shall be modified unless agreed to by producer in writing. Both parties agree all disagreements will be decided by arbitration in the state where the show is produced.
- G) **No commercial advertising is allowed with entries unless they are appearing in conjunction with paid commercial space.** A single sign may be used to identify major modifications, identifying who did them, and what equipment was used, but large ad signs, handbills or business card distribution is prohibited.
- H) In consideration of this entry, the owner, spouse, and guests, agree to permit the PRS/MHRC or its assign the use of their names and pictures of the entered vehicle for publicity, advertising, and commercial purposes (including newspapers, magazines, radio, television, and Internet) before, during, and after the event, and do hereby relinquish any rights whatsoever to any photos taken in connection with the event, and hereby give permission to publish or sell or otherwise dispose of said photographs to PRS/MHRC or its assigns. All publicity and advertising rights are reserved by the PRS/MHRC or its assigns.

I will comply with the following Uniform Fire Code Regulations.

Uniform Fire Code: Vehicle will have less than one-quarter (1/4) tank of fuel or entry to building will be denied. Gas cap will be taped off, Battery cables will be disconnected and cable ends taped prior to safety inspection. NO hay or emergency flares in displays. NO compressed Gas Cylinders of any type.
